Landmark High School Summer School 2024

At Landmark High School

Term 1- 21 days- Monday through Friday- Starting May 30 – Ending June 28

Time- 8:30-12:05 4- 50 minute face to face class periods.

Term 2- Assigned Edgenuity Courses

Credit recovery only, no initial credit

Current Nebo School District freshman, sophomore, junior, and seniors

Class sizes are usually 15-20 students.

1.0 credit offered through face to face instruction- math, science, English, History

Math options- .25 or .5 of Math 1, Math 2, Math 3

English options .25 or .5 of English 9, 10, 11, 12 (6 different class options)

Science options- .25 or .5 of Earth Systems, Biology

History options- .25 .5 of US History, Geography, World Civilizations

Edgenuity Online courses- Chemistry, Health, US Gov, Psychology, Fitness

Edgenuity classroom- During the summer school class rotation, we also provide a classroom with a support staff for students to work on their online Edgenuity courses. Students will also have an opportunity to work from home on one or more Edgenuity courses and earn more credit.

Edgenuity Test out option- One time test out option is available before starting any Edgenuity courses. If the student does not pass the test out option there are internal pre-chapter quizzes to help students move past chapters they are already familiar with. Students must pass chapter tests with 70% to move on to the next chapter.

All Edgenuity courses have a proctored final test that must be completed at Landmark

Special Education- There is an inclusion option and IEP support for our summer school IEP students.

Landmark High Policies/Procedures- We will be following the Landmark High Attendance and Cell Phone policy. If a student misses 5 or more days of a summer school class they cannot earn credit for that class. Cell phones must be put away during class time or they are taken away until after the class or after school. **New this year.** There are vape detectors in all bathrooms. If a student is caught with a vape they will be suspended and loose the opportunity to attend summer school.

Landmark Recruiting Tool- There are many positives- Students are able to meet and get to know many Landmark staff and teachers. They also become familiar with the school and its policies and procedures. The majority of student's complete summer school and leave with a positive experience.

Bus needs- Nebo Buses with pick-up and delivery. One bus with stops in Goshen, Genola, Santaquin, Payson and Salem. A second bus with stops in Springville, Mapleton, and Spanish Fork.

Breakfast/lunch- We will be working with the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and Utah Food Bank to offer a free breakfast and sack lunch to all summer school students.

Referral Process- Referral must be sent from student's regular high school counselor indicating the credit recovery needs to be completed through summer school and/or Edgenuity courses

Summer School Registration- Online registration through the Landmark High School Webpage

Senior Graduation Needs- Every year we are able to meet those last few credits needed for a few senior students so they can graduate from either Landmark or their regular high school by August 1
