

Upcoming School Plan 2024-2025 - Landmark High (SLT)

Goal #1 State Goal

- In the upcoming academic year, our goal is to support students in successfully completing their education and progressing towards graduation by implementing strategies aimed at reducing the percentage of students receiving F grades. Over the next three years, we aim to maintain our current graduation rate of 80% or higher, as our average graduation rate over the past 8 years is 71%.

Measurements

- Since 2020, Landmark High School has averaged a graduation rate of 79.2%. The highest of those being 81.2% in 2021 and the lowest being 75.4% in 2020. We will measure this by tracking the number of seniors enrolled at Landmark and the total graduates in each mini term as well as those making adequate progress to return to their regular High Schools (this accounts for <2% of Landmark enrollees). We will track credit deficient students on a weekly basis within the framework of Youth Support Meeting and make specific plans to assist those students in making up credit and progressing towards graduation. Included in this tracking process we will make individual and schoolwide interventions to assist both students with I.E.P.s and those without. Included in those interventions will be a Study Skills Class for identified deficient students needing extra remediation.

1. We will hire a Study Skills Technician who will provide academic support during regular school hours. (\$42,539.18)
2. Identify at-risk students through collaboration between counseling, administration, and teachers, and enroll them in a dedicated Study Skills class within the daily schedule (to work with the technician).
3. Monitor student progress regularly and adjust support strategies accordingly.
4. Maintain open communication between teachers, counselors, administrators, and parents to ensure a coordinated approach to supporting student success.
